



HOUSE KEY VOTES FOR THE 106TH CONGRESS

1. MANDATES INFORMATION ACT

February 10, 1999. A bill (H.R. 350) by Reps. Gary Condit (D-Calif.) and Rob Portman (R-Ohio) to force Congress to hold separate debates and votes when considering legislation that would cost the private sector more than \$100 million to implement. Passed (274-149). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

2. KUCINICH AMENDMENT TO THE SMALL BUSINESS PAPERWORK REDUCTION ACT AMENDMENTS

February 11, 1999. Amendment by Rep. Dennis Kucinich (D-Ohio) to a bill (H.R. 391) by Rep. David McIntosh (R-Ind.). The bill suspends civil fines on small businesses for first-time, non-harmful paperwork violations and gives small businesses six months to correct the problem. The Kucinich amendment would have allowed agencies to continue to impose burdensome penalties for groundless paperwork violations. Failed (210-214). National Restaurant Association Position: No.

3. FY 2000 BUDGET RESOLUTION

March 25, 1999. A GOP resolution (H. Con. Res. 68) that lays the groundwork for a fiscal plan to help save Social Security, pay down the national debt, and provide approximately \$15 million in tax cuts. Passed (221-208). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

4. FINANCIAL FREEDOM ACT

July 22, 1999. A bill (H.R. 2488) by Rep. Bill Archer (R-Texas) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to, among other things, extend the Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC), increase the business-meal deduction, reduce individual income tax rates, provide marriage-penalty relief, and provide estate and gift tax relief. Passed (223-208). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

5. ERGONOMICS: WORKPLACE PRESERVATION ACT

August 3, 1999. A bill (H.R. 987) by Rep. Roy Blunt (R-Mo.) to ensure that OSHA cannot move forward on a repetitive-stress-injuries rulemaking until Congress has reviewed the results of an already-underway National Academy of Sciences (NAS) study on the issue. Passed (217-209). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

6. HEALTH CARE: QUALITY CARE FOR THE UNINSURED ACT

Oct. 6, 1999. A bill (H.R. 2990) by Reps. Jim Talent (R-Mo.), Dennis Hastert (R-Ill.) and John Shadegg (R-Ariz.) to make health insurance more affordable by, among other things, allowing associations to sponsor health plans for their members; accelerating the tax

deductibility of health insurance costs for the self-employed and expanding the use of medical savings accounts. Passed (227-205). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

7. HEALTH CARE: BIPARTISAN CONSENSUS MANAGED CARE IMPROVEMENT ACT

Oct. 7, 1999. A bill (H.R. 2723) by Reps. Charles Norwood (R-Ga.) and John Dingell (D-Mich.) that would create new mandates for health insurance plans and expand employer liability. Passed (275-151). National Restaurant Association Position: No.

8. SMALL BUSINESS LIABILITY REFORM ACT

February 16, 2000. A bill (H.R. 2366) by Reps. Jim Rogan (R-Calif.) and Tim Holden (D-Pa.) to cap punitive damage awards in civil cases for businesses with 25 or fewer employees and limit exposure to joint and several liability. Passed (221-193). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

9. SENIOR CITIZENS' FREEDOM TO WORK ACT

March 1, 2000. A bill (H.R. 5) by Rep. Sam Johnson (R-Texas) to eliminate the Social Security earnings test, which reduces Social Security benefits for Americans over 70 who earn more than \$17,000 a year. Passed (422-0). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

10. MINIMUM WAGE (TRAFICANT AMENDMENT)

March 9, 2000. An amendment to H.R. 3846 by Rep. James Traficant (D-Ohio) to increase the minimum wage by \$1 over two years. (This amendment changed the language of the original bill, which provided for a \$1 increase in the starting wage over three years.) Passed (246-179). National Restaurant Association position: No.

11. MINIMUM WAGE (FINAL PASSAGE)

March 9, 2000. A vote on final passage of H.R. 3846 to increase the minimum wage by \$1 over a two-year period. Passed (282-143). National Restaurant Association position: No.

12. COMPREHENSIVE RETIREMENT SECURITY AND PENSION REFORM ACT

July 19, 2000. A bill (H.R. 1102) by Reps. Rob Portman (R-Ohio) and Ben Cardin (D-Md.) to allow employers greater access to more affordable pension plans for their employees by increasing IRA contributions, expanding coverage, reducing regulatory burdens and increasing portability. (Passed 401-25). National Restaurant Association position: Yes.

July 13, 1999. An amendment by Sen. Rick Santorum (R-Pa.) to the Patients' Bill of Rights (S. 1344) to provide, among other things, for 100% deductibility of health insurance costs for the self-employed. Passed (53-47). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

2. PATIENTS' BILL OF RIGHTS: GREGG AMENDMENT

July 15, 1999. An amendment by Sen. Judd Gregg (R-N.H.) to the Patients' Bill of Rights (S. 1134) to strike from the underlying bill provisions that would increase liability for employers who provide health benefits. Passed (53-47). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

3. TAXPAYER REFUND ACT

July 30, 1999. A bill (S. 1429) to provide nearly \$800 billion in tax relief, including a five-year extension of the Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC). Passed (57-43). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

4. TAXPAYER REFUND AND RELIEF ACT

August 5, 1999. Conference report on a bill (H.R. 2488) to provide tax relief, including a 30-month extension of the Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) and an increase in the business meal deduction from 50 to 60 percent. The bill also reduces income taxes, cuts the capital gains tax, eliminates the "death tax," and provides 100 percent deductibility of health insurance costs for the self-employed. Passed (50-49). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

5. MINIMUM WAGE

November 9, 1999. Motion to table (kill) an amendment by Sen. Edward Kennedy (D-Mass.) to S. 625 (bankruptcy reform) to increase the federal minimum wage by \$1 over 13 months. Passed (50-48). National Restaurant Association Position: Yes.

6. DEATH TAX ELIMINATION ACT

July 14, 2000. A bill, H.R. 8, sponsored by Rep. Jennifer Dunn (R-Wash.) to gradually eliminate estate and gift taxes over a 10-year period. Passed (59-39). National Restaurant Association position: Yes.
