KEY VOTES

1. HEALTH CARE: ACCESS AMENDMENT

August 2, 2001. A vote on an amendment to patients' right legislation adding Association Health Plans and extending permanently the availability of Medical Savings Accounts to employees of firms of all sizes. Passed (236–194). National Restaurant Association position: **YES**

2. ESTATE TAX: REPEAL

April 4, 2001. A vote on H.R. 8, the Death Tax Elimination Act, which repealed the federal estate tax. This bill was later incorporated into a larger tax relief measure, which became law. Passed (274–154). National Restaurant Association position: **YES**

3. TAX CUTS: MARGINAL TAX RATES CUT

March 8, 2001. A vote on H.R. 3, the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Act, which replaced, the current five-rate tax structure of 15, 28, 31, 36 and 39.6 percent with four lower rates—10, 15, 25 and 33 percent. Passed (230–198). National Restaurant Association position: **YES**

4. ERGONOMICS: REPEAL OF OSHA RULE

March 7, 2001. A vote on S.J.Res. 6, a resolution of disapproval overturning the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's ergonomics regulation. (Passed 223–206). National Restaurant Association position: **YES**

5. ESTATE TAX: PERMANENT REPEAL

June 7, 2002. A vote on H.R. 2143, which would make permanent the repeal of the estate tax enacted by the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Act of 2001. Passed (256–171). National Restaurant Association Position: **YES**
