Restaurants in Illinois are a driving force in the state's economy. Their sales generate tremendous tax revenues. They provide jobs and build careers for thousands of people. In 2012, Illinois's restaurants are projected to register **\$20.7 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in Illinois's restaurants generates an additional **\$1.25** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **24,337** eating and drinking places in Illinois.



Every extra \$1 million spent in Illinois's restaurants generates an additional **26.2** jobs in the state.

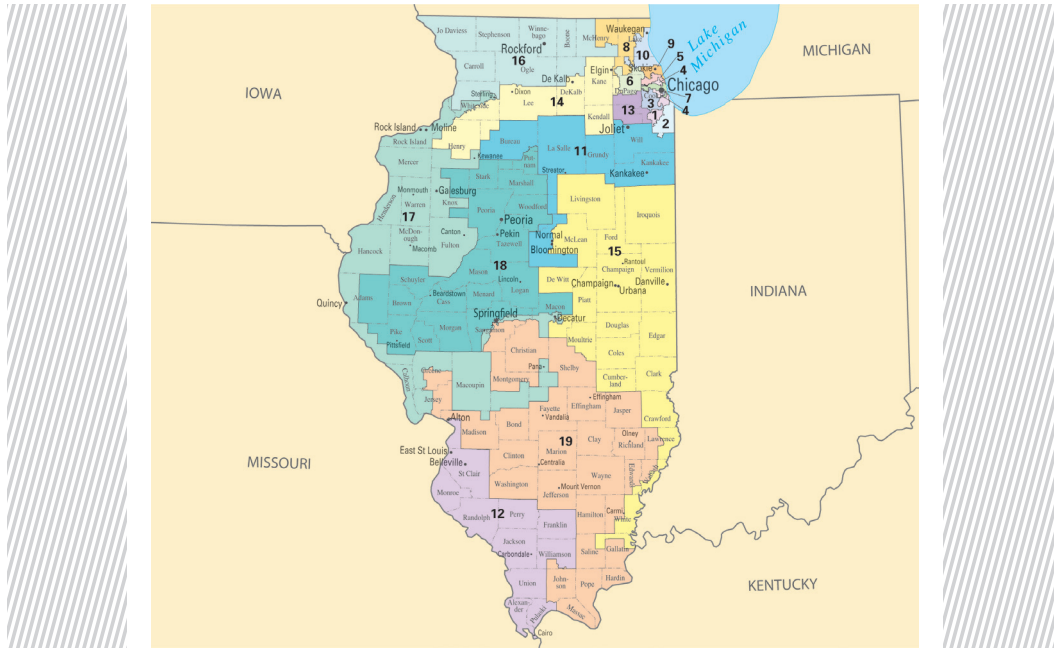
