Restaurants in Montana are a driving force in the state's economy. Their sales generate tremendous tax revenues. They provide jobs and build careers for thousands of people. In 2012, Montana's restaurants are projected to register **\$1.4 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in Montana's restaurants generates an additional **\$.70** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **2,586** eating and drinking places in Montana.



Every extra \$1 million spent in Montana's restaurants generates an additional **30.3** jobs in the state.
