In 2012, New York's restaurants are projected to register **\$31.9 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in New York's restaurants generates an additional **\$.86** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **41,221** eating and drinking places in New York.



Every extra \$1 million spent in New York's restaurants generates an additional **20.2** jobs in the state.
