In 2012, Ohio's restaurants are projected to register **\$16.6 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in Ohio's restaurants generates an additional **\$1.14** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **21,302** eating and drinking places in Ohio.



Every extra \$1 million spent in Ohio's restaurants generates an additional **30.3** jobs in the state.
