Restaurants in Oregon are a driving force in the state's economy. Their sales generate tremendous tax revenues. They provide jobs and build careers for thousands of people. In 2012, Oregon's restaurants are projected to register **\$6.2 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in Oregon's restaurants generates an additional **\$.97** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **8,660** eating and drinking places in Oregon.



Every extra \$1 million spent in Oregon's restaurants generates an additional **26.6** jobs in the state.

In 2022

Restaurants in Oregon are projected to employ **192,500** people
(12.6% job growth — 21,600 new jobs)

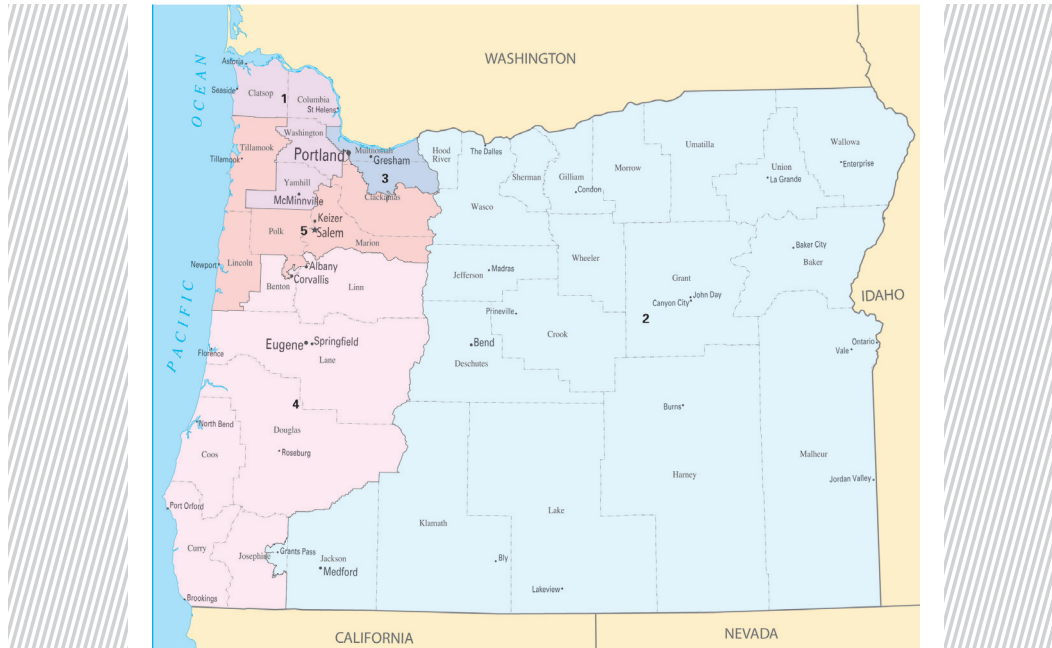
