Restaurants in Pennsylvania are a driving force in the state's economy. Their sales generate tremendous tax revenues. They provide jobs and build careers for thousands of people. In 2012, Pennsylvania's restaurants are projected to register **\$17.1 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in Pennsylvania's restaurants generates an additional **\$1.16** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **24,196** eating and drinking places in Pennsylvania.



Every extra \$1 million spent in Pennsylvania's restaurants generates an additional **28.7** jobs in the state.

(9% of employment in Pennsylvania)

### In 2022

Restaurants in Pennsylvania are projected to employ **565,900** people  
(5.2% job growth — 28,000 new jobs)

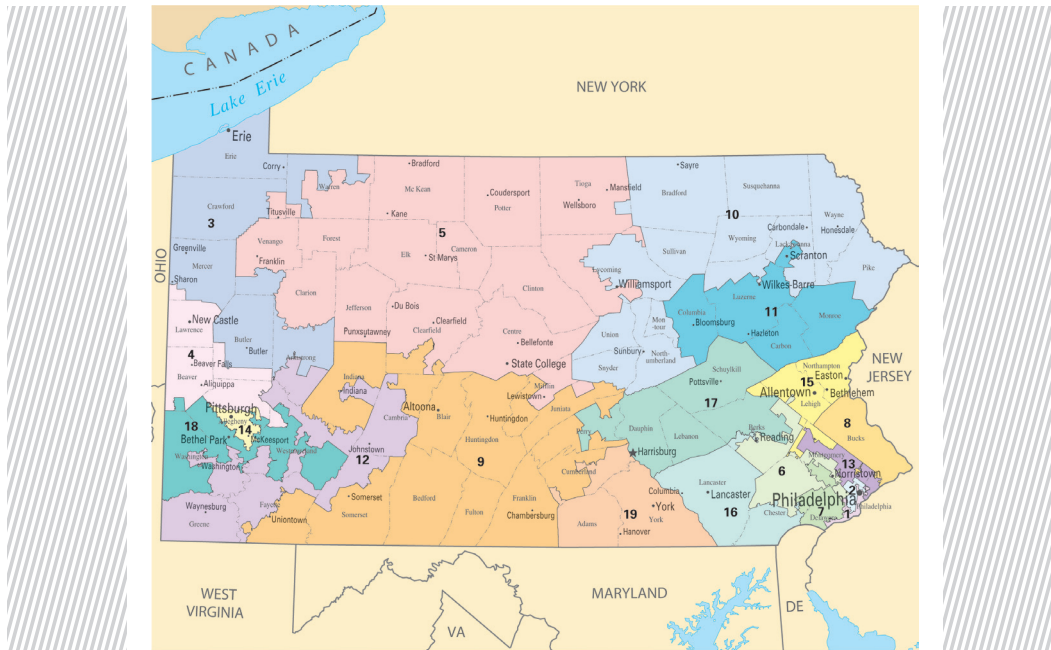
