Restaurants in Tennessee are a driving force in the state's economy. Their sales generate tremendous tax revenues. They provide jobs and build careers for thousands of people. In 2012, Tennessee's restaurants are projected to register **\$9.4 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in Tennessee's restaurants generates an additional **\$1.11** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **9,017** eating and drinking places in Tennessee.



Every extra \$1 million spent in Tennessee's restaurants generates an additional **27.3** jobs in the state.

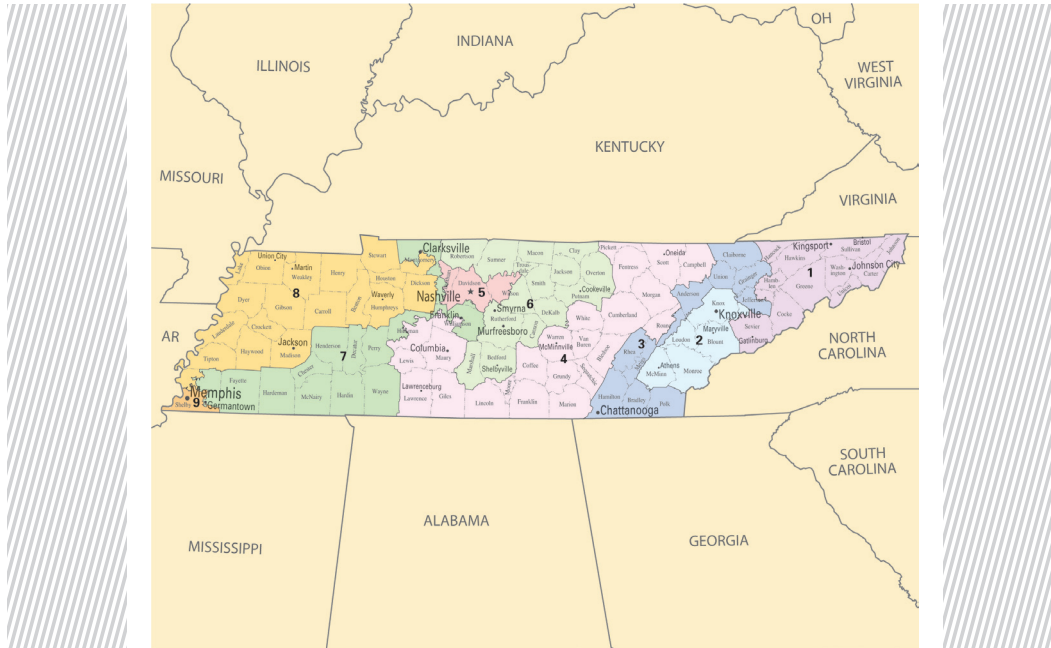
