Restaurants in Vermont are a driving force in the state's economy. Their sales generate tremendous tax revenues. They provide jobs and build careers for thousands of people. In 2012, Vermont's restaurants are projected to register **\$.8 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in Vermont's restaurants generates an additional **\$.71** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **1,341** eating and drinking places in Vermont.



Every extra \$1 million spent in Vermont's restaurants generates an additional **25.6** jobs in the state.

In 2022

Restaurants in Vermont are projected to employ **31,600** people
(7.1% job growth — 2,100 new jobs)
