



Expansion of Off Premise Alcohol Sales

This guidance document is about states that allowed for the Expansion of Off Premise Alcohol Sales from March, 2020- July 2021. We are no longer updating this document. We are working on creating a new off premise alcohol industry resource in partnership with a law firm to address a few topics that require more specialized alcohol law and regulation expertise.

It provides information about:

- Alcohol restrictions and curfews
- If alcohol delivery was allowed prior to COVID
- If cocktail delivery is currently not allowed or allowed on a temporary or permanent basis.
- Expiration dates for temporary alcohol delivery Executive Orders or laws
- If there is pending cocktails to go legislation in progress
- If a food purchase is required with alcohol purchase
- Cocktails to go orders, laws, regulations and specifications.
- To go container requirements
- The types of alcohol and volume of alcohol that can be delivered
- Curbside pick up alcohol requirements
- If a third party can deliver alcohol
