## RESTAURANT INDUSTRY AT A GLANCE


Restaurants are a driving force in Hawaii's economy. They provide jobs and build careers for thousands of people, and play a vital role in local communities throughout the state.



**3,665**

### HOW DOES THE RESTAURANT INDUSTRY IMPACT THE HAWAII ECONOMY?

Every dollar spent in the tableservice segment contributes \$1.82 to the state economy.

Every dollar spent in the limited-service segment contributes \$1.53 to the state economy.
