

### ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTIONS

OF THE RESTAURANT & FOODSERVICE INDUSTRY



In 2025, Connecticut's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$16.27B** in direct economic output to the state's economy, support **144,866** jobs, and deliver **\$6.0B** in labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's economic impact rises to \$27.58B in output, supporting 191,330 jobs, and \$10.08B in labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will **\$2.82B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$664.58M in state taxes and \$1.49B in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, contributions will reach **\$4.58B in taxes**, with \$1.06B in state taxes and \$2.55B in federal taxes.







