OF THE RESTAURANT & FOODSERVICE INDUSTRY



SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Hawaii's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$9.68B in direct economic output** to the state's economy, support **81,082 jobs**, and deliver **\$3.57B in total labor income**, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$15.16B in output, supporting 106,178 jobs, and \$5.29B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$1.41B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$60.51M in county taxes, \$456.19M in state taxes and \$783.43M in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$2.19B in taxes**, with \$99.95M in county taxes, \$735.3M in state taxes and \$1.17B in federal taxes.







