

### ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTIONS

OF THE RESTAURANT & FOODSERVICE INDUSTRY



SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Nevada's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$23.88B in direct economic output** to the state's economy, support **192,044 jobs**, and deliver **\$8.35B in total labor income**, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$38.23B in output, supporting 257,621 jobs, and \$12.84B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$4.64B** in taxes to all levels of government, including \$425.3M in county taxes, \$1.67B in state taxes and \$2.18B in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$6.54B** in taxes, with \$545.62M in county taxes, \$2.15B in state taxes and \$3.39B in federal taxes.







