SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Nebraska's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$8.57B** in direct economic output to the state's economy, support **88,120** jobs, and deliver **\$2.46B** in total labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$14.57B in output, supporting 114,006 jobs, and \$4.25B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$1.34B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$65.37M in county taxes, \$323.44M in state taxes and \$564.96M in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$2.02B in taxes**, with \$84.18M in county taxes, \$449.13M in state taxes and \$989.08M in federal taxes.







