

## ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTIONS

OF THE RESTAURANT & FOODSERVICE INDUSTRY



SUMMER 2025 In 2025, North Carolina's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$46.58B** in direct economic output to the state's economy, support **482,573 jobs**, and deliver **\$14.69B** in total labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$83.46B in output, supporting 643,807 jobs, and \$26.49B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$5.63B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$657.67M in county taxes, \$1.36B in state taxes and \$3.33B in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$10.23B in taxes**, with \$1.17B in county taxes, \$2.46B in state taxes and \$6.11B in federal taxes.




