OF THE RESTAURANT & FOODSERVICE INDUSTRY



SUMMER 2025 In 2024, Ohio's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$51.55B in direct economic output** to the state's economy, support **528,116 jobs**, and deliver **\$15.92B in total labor income**, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$92.35B in output, supporting 712,555 jobs, and \$28.63B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$7.06B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$401.89M in county taxes, \$1.89B in state taxes and \$3.52B in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$12.12B in taxes**, with \$622.54M in county taxes, \$2.99B in state taxes and \$6.52B in federal taxes.







