SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Pennsylvania's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$50.02B** in direct economic output to the Commonwealth's economy, support **504,848** jobs, and deliver **\$16.3B** in total labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$88.71B in output, supporting 674,632 jobs, and \$29.7B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$7.57B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$224.20M in county taxes, \$2.11B in state taxes and \$3.72B in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$12.82B in taxes**, with \$332.77M in county taxes, \$3.33B in state taxes and \$6.87B in federal taxes.







