SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Rhode Island's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$5.62B** in direct economic output to the state's economy, support **53,493** jobs, and deliver **\$1.94B** in total labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to **\$9.19B in output**, supporting **69,735 jobs**, and **\$3.15B in total labor income**.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$997.56M in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$278.43M in state taxes and \$456.64M in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$1.5B in taxes**, with \$393.41M in state taxes and \$747.85M in federal taxes.




